Important Reminders!

Arriving to School

Although staff are usually here from 7.30am, a time-tabled staff member is on duty from *8.00am*.

Note #1: Should you drop your son/daughter off BEFORE 8.00am, we are unable to assure you of their supervisionand the classrooms MAY be locked.

Departing From School

How your child leaves school can change from day-to-day due to changes in family circumstances and/or work commitments. We understand this!

However, please let us know WHEN there is to be a change such as:

- Changes in bus travel ie bus \mathbf{v} no bus \mathbf{v} car
- Changes in car travel ie car v no car v bus
 - Changes in WHO will be picking up
- Communication can be via school cell phone text 021 0291 9131

Note #2: We are not able to be told and take 'word of mouth' messages from your child if we don't know officially from you. eg ''Mum's picking me up today so I'm not on the bus."

Unless we are advised, your child will travel as they normally would.

Note #3: If travel is by car, the whiteboard outside the Office MUST be used to show that your son/daughter has actually left. (See pic below)

Note #4: At 3.20pm, all students who have NOT been picked up will be sitting on the seat outside the Office area waiting to be collected in person! This is so we know who is still on our school grounds.



Note #5: If your son/daughter leaves school early, please sign-out using the VisTab tablet by the door in the School Office area.
