PTA Donation

The **PTA** has generously agreed to donate **\$2000.00** towards **20** Moon Pads (cool floor pads to sit on like in Rooms 4 and 5) and **2** Moon Pad trolleys for the Block A classrooms, along with 1 bench top oven and 1 microwave for the Block A multi-purpose room.

The multi-purpose room, which includes two large sinks, two stainless steel benches and one mobile bench, is designed as a wet area for activities such as food technology, visual art and science-based learning, as well as being a third breakout space for day to day teaching and learning.

The multi-purpose room and the two breakout spaces along the southern side of Block A will be available to all classes/teachers to use through a booking schedule.

Staff Professional Learning

1. On **Monday 22 June**, the teaching staff continue with their professional learning with **Mrs Shirley Collins**, our Mathematics facilitator from the Institute of Professional Learning-University of Waikato.

Shirley will spend the day in classes observing teachers in action followed by a staff meeting at 3.40pm when further learning opportunities will be shared.

I look forward to your input if at all possible.


