<u>Speed in the Zone</u>

Following my emailed concerns to **Rotorua Lakes Council**, forwarded to the Rotorua Policing Unit, I was pleased to see the speed camera here on both Monday and Thursday mornings this week between approx. 7.50am and 10.15am.

Here's the data...

<u>Monday 3 August:</u>

- 14 infringements
- Minimum infringement speed (to be ticketed) **75** (as it's a school zone-a reduced tolerance)
- Maximum infringement speed **128**! (Note #1: In thick fog and at 8.50am & Note #2: this is a different **128** to last weeks!)

<u>Thursday 6 August</u>:

- **10** infringements
- Minimum infringement speed 81
- Maximum infringement speed 90

Driver speed through our school zone at the moment is at a level I have not experienced in a long time! Other than the 128, these figures don't fairly reflect the speed and craziness we experience throughout any given day.

It is unacceptable! I am concerned! I will continue to lobby to ensure that we have a strong enforcement presence within our zone.
