

Forthcoming Events - Important

Due to COVID-19 and our current position under Alert Level 2, a number of sporting and cultural events have been affected, either through postponement or cancellation.

The **BOP Rippa Rugby**, **Cluster Cross Country** and **CBOP Cross Country** events have been cancelled for Term 2.

The **Cluster Cultural Festival** is postponed at this stage. A decision to hold it in either Term 3 or to cancel will be made at a later date.

The **Broadlands School Cross Country** training and event will continue, albeit delayed. How the event is organised will depend, in part, on the Alert Level at the time, although I expect it to be at Level 1.

The provisional date for our school **Cross Country** is **Wednesday 1 June**. Details to follow.

The bikes, helmets and bike trail project is on hold as my chosen funding source has 'dried up' a little as a result of C-19 at Alert Levels 4 and 3. I will re-submit the current application to the NZCT once given the go ahead by them. I will update you in due course.

Board of Trustees - Block A Re-development Update

Despite the delay, the Block A re-development is progressing well on the main Wade Construction contract.

Work will start shortly on the refurbishment of the actual three classroom spaces/Rooms 1-3 which, in brief, will involve the:

- removal of all old sinks/wet areas
- removal of all old shelving and cabinetry
- total stripping of all walls for gibbing
- installation of new skirtings and scotia to paint finish
- installation of autex composition over the gib3
- installation of three open/sliding door cavities between the classrooms, (already started as part of the current contract)
- re-carpeting (approx. 1.8m around the outside of the existing carpet to match)
- installation of three new teaching/storage units
- installation of LED lighting
- addition of the three new Samsung 65" UHD Commercial-grade SMART TV's, each on a trolley
- addition of some other new furniture and items like stools, microwave, mini oven, cooking materials...

As we need to clear out all teaching and learning materials and furniture from Rooms 1-3 for the above to happen, there will be a 6m container placed outside Rooms 4 & 5 (field-side) some next week.

All going to plan, we might be in Block A for the beginning of Term 3! :-)

Exciting times and great too, to have things to look forward to!




