

Alert Level Easing

Over the last two weeks we have not been holding school assemblies due to the numbers involved which is in keeping with Alert Level 2 MoH guidelines.

As of 12.00 Noon today, the Government is allowing the easing of gathering size to 100.

As such, from **Tuesday 2 June**, we will be holding smaller assembly gatherings for Rooms 4, 5 & 1 (Years 1-3) and for Rooms 2 & 3 (Years 5-6) which will enable us to keep a reasonable level of physical distancing.

Expectations around sanitising throughout the day and managing physical distancing within class will naturally continue for some time until Alert Level 1.

Thank you for your efforts so far.


Block A Redevelopment
