I am delighted to advise that the application to the **NZ Community Trust** has resulted in a funding grant of *\$8115.44* to purchase *20* bikes and *24* helmets has been successful.

Whilst there is a national shortage of bikes due to the overwhelming demand (as a sport gaining huge momentum), we will have the bikes available to begin 2021.

I am sourcing a good 40ft container for secure storage at this time which I expect to have in place during Term 4. A project for Term 1 2021 will also be to paint the container in an appropriate and naturally-blended way.

A process will also begin this term for the construction of a bike trail, including skills obstacles, around three sides of the main field.
