Board of Trustees - Tree Work

During Term 3, the Board undertook an independent H & S audit of the trees on our school site through **Tyronne Whittaker** - **Elite Climbing Arb Contractors**.

As a result of the audit, a number of trees require either pruning or removal.

The Ministry of Education has approved their funding of the project in the amount of **\$31,990.00+GST**.

This work commenced on-site on Monday 2 November.

Having purchased approx. \$6k worth of equipment a number of years ago, we are now re-commencing our **PMP** classes for our Year 1's during Term 4 and into 2021. PMP sessions are of 30 minutes duration and held 2-3 times a week in the Broadlands Hall.

The Perceptual Motor Programme (PMP) is a physical skills programme that aims to increase children's fine and gross motor skills, coordination, concentration, eye tracking skills and memory through a variety of activities and games.

Our gymnastic classes will add another layer of developmental/coordination/concentration opportunities for our entire school. FYI, gymnastics will become a more significant part of our PE programme from 2021.

Our school Athletics Day will be held on **Wednesday 11 November**.

School will commence at 8.50am this day with our Athletics Day events commencing at **9.00am** and will finish by **3.00pm**. We look forward to seeing you here at some stage through the day. We need some parent helpers during the day as time-keepers and recorders. If you can spare a few hours to help, please let the school Office or your child's teacher know ASAP. If you are helping, you will get to see your child at each event.

Your child will need to bring:

- Sports tee shirt and shorts (no singlets)
- Warm top/fleece (just in case)
- School sun hat (named)
- Bare feet or sports shoes
- Morning tea and lunch
- Drink bottle (water only)
- Sunscreen will be provided during the day

- Track sprints & distance


