I have attached a pic of the board below which hangs outside the School Office.

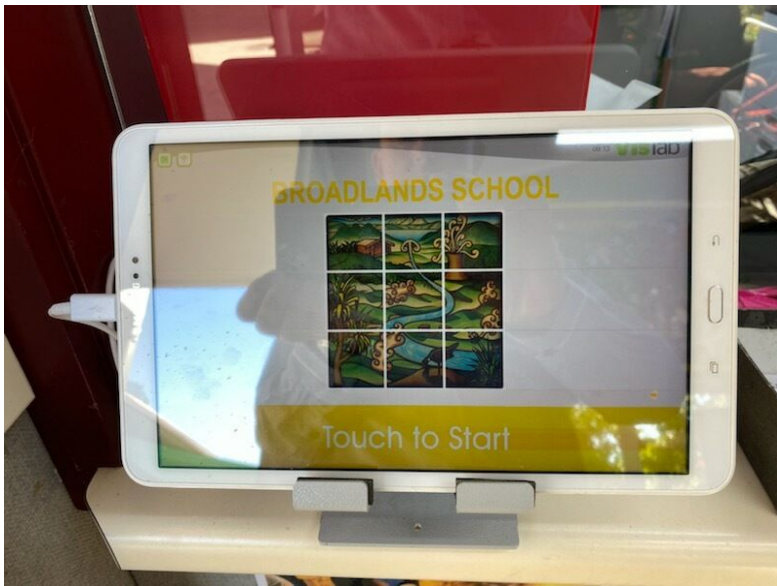
