Learning Support Programmes 2021 - *In brief* (last week PMP and BRICKS Club)

Here are two more of the learning support interventions we are offering this year.

Accelerated Learning in Literacy - ALL & Accelerated Learning in Mathematics - ALiM

Both **ALL** and **ALiM** are Ministry of Education-funded programmes for schools intervention in literacy and numeracy which are supported by facilitators from the University of Waikato throughout the year. They provide additional more in-depth learning opportunities and support for small groups of students.

Teachers will inquire into their own teaching practice in order to develop their own knowledge and build teacher capability. ALL and ALiM Workshops are held throughout the year.

At Broadlands School, **Mrs Sandham** (Year 5/6) will lead **ALL** working together with **Mrs Wilson** (NE/Year1). **Mrs Lynch** (Year 4/5) will lead **ALiM** working together with **Miss Bentley** (Year 2/3).

For your information, data is gathered and reported to the Board of Trustees at the end of 2021.

Whānau of the tamariki involved will be informed by the teacher if they are to be included in either of these.

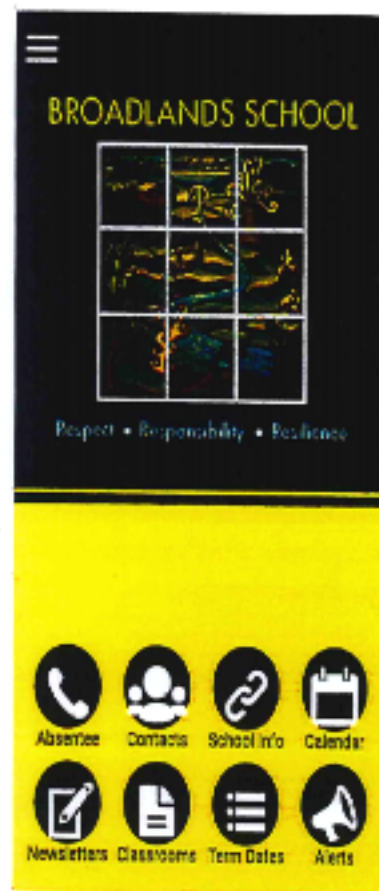
Our School App will not replace the School Website and/or Seesaw and/or the weekly Newsletter, but mutually support.
