Each has its own purpose, but I would like to focus on our **SchoolApp**.

SchoolApp provides you with instant messages, for example, reminders for upcoming school events, team or class announcements and most importantly, emergency situations such as fire, earthquake and school lockdowns (which could happen at any time!)

Being instant, it is a much more efficient than email or Facebook.

It is important that **EVERYBODY** is connected ASAP. If you need help with this, please ask a staff member or Kasey in the Office.

Get this! To give you a little time and as an incentive, in this week's *Broadlands Bulletin* I will place a 'hidden code' for you to find.

Sometime next Friday, Kasey and I will send out a **SchoolApp** message for you to provide the code by return **SchoolApp** message.

1. **Make sure you have downloaded the app SchoolAppsNZ. To make it easy use the QR code. (Below)**
2. **Open up SchoolApp**
3. **Click on 'Absentee'**
4. **Click on 'TXT office' OR 'Email'**
5. **Type in the hidden code**
6. **Send.**

The **FIRST** person to respond with the correct code will receive a **\$20.00 CREDIT** to their school account. The second, **\$10.00**.

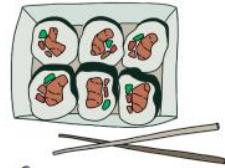
