
Electronic/Fixed Road Speed Signage - 'Heads Up'

Great news!

You may be aware that there has been a review of the current speed limit review within the Reporoa Valley. Following this review, a recommendation was made to the Rotorua Lakes Council Strategy, Policy and Finance committee to amend current speed limits outside a number of Reporoa Valley schools including Waikite Valley School, Lake Rerewhakaaitu School and Broadlands School. This recommendation was approved unopposed.

Niki Carling, Safe and Sustainable Journeys Manager at Rotorua Lakes Council, has since advised that the installation of the new signage will begin the week just past.

This will include two fixed **60 km/h** speed signs and two electronic variable speed signs showing **40 km/h** around 9.00am and 3.00pm each day.
