It's that time of the year again!

Past, present or future friends and families of Broadlands School are asked to join our group of farmers rearing and donating a 100kg fresian bull calf.

What is a friesian bull calf?

Calves that are presented must have five white points and a white star on the forehead.

Important details

Calves must be born on or before **10 August 2021.** This will ensure that the target weight of **100kg** is achievable by **31 October 2021.**

All bull calves must be NAIT registered with their farm and at time of sale. They will be transferred to the Broadlands NAIT number. Ross Shaw/Stephen O'Reilly will organise this.

Simon Marra from Silver Fern Farms will be handling the sale process.

LEARN TO SAIL



Our Clubs learn to sail program starts Monday 1 November (please meet at the beach in front of the yacht club, 4:30pm)

If you are interested in having a go, then do it! Here's what you need to know:

- You need to commit for the summer season, but the further we get into summer the warmer the water gets!
- The courses are run along a prescribed Yachting NZ course module with certified instructors.
- The cost is \$315 (a family membership to yacht club). This cost covers tuition at 5pm each Monday evening which runs until the end of daylight saving, as well as the use of club boats, life jackets and the YNZ affiliation fee.
- Through this course, you are also welcome to come sailing each Saturday afternoon on a
 more relaxed basis. We sail to the <u>Two Mile</u> Bay sailing centre for an ice cream or coffee.
 And on Wednesday evenings Club racing is held, plus a very cost-effective dinner at the club
 afterwards for any hungry family. <u>So</u> there is plenty of sailing opportunity!
