EcoGas Partnership

You will see that the construction of New Zealand's first large-scale food waste to bioenergy facility at Broadlands is progressing well.

Some facts FYI:

- The venture is owned by Ecogas; a joint venture between Pioneer Energy Ltd and Ecostock Supplies Ltd; on land owned by T&G Fresh, one of New Zealand's largest fresh produce businesses.
- Each year the facility is expected to remove up to 10,000 tonnes of carbon dioxide; the equivalent of planting 218,400 trees every year.
- The world-class facility will help New Zealand deal with some of the 327,000 annual tonnes of food waste that would otherwise go into landfills.

Through Broadlands School's partnership with EcoGas, I am delighted to advise that **Andrew Fisher**, **EcoGas Managing Director**, has agreed to sponsor an additional EPro8 Science and Engineering kit for Broadlands School (giving us two) to the value of **\$1556.52+GST**.














Cleaner Position
