Covid-19 - IMPORTANT UPDATE!

I do not wish to bombard you with too much extra information or massively re-summarise the latest Red Traffic Light - Phase 3 announcements from **Thursday 24 February** as there is plenty of information out there.


However, most importantly to the well-being of our school community, please:

- 1. Remain vigilant about symptoms.
- 2. STAY AWAY if you OR your child show symptoms.
- 3. If symptoms show, get a test.
- 4. ONLY HOUSEHOLD CONTACTS of a POSITIVE case must isolate for a period of 10 days and have two negative tests.
- 5. All other close and casual contacts, including classmates, must be watched closely for symptoms.
- 6. Advise the Principal immediately if you OR your child were likely POSITIVE whilst at school.

The school will also isolate your child and contact you immediately IF your child shows symptoms whilst at school.

Our current hygiene, masking, 'bubble' and outside space management will continue until further notice.

We understand that from time-to-time, travel arrangements for your child/children **after school** will change. However, it is also important that Kasey/Office or Graeme/Principal are aware of these changes.

A child telling us is NOT acceptable.

For example 1: If a child NORMALLY goes home by bus, but on this particular day, is going to a friend's place after school with another parent, we MUST know.

We check off all names on our bus travel rolls every afternoon so we expect your child to be there UNLESS other arrangements have been made that we know of.

For example 2: If a child NORMALLY travels by car, but on this day, is travelling by bus, then we MUST know of this change.

IF we don't know, please don't be disappointed WHEN we say NO!

Broadlands School Water Skills and Swimming Sports 2022



Kia ora, Broadlands Parents/Caregivers & Whānau,

We will be holding our annual Broadlands School Water Skills and Swimming Sports on Wednesday 3 March 2022.

However, you will understand the requirement to modify our organisation in order to meet the Ministry of Education / Ministry of Health - Covid-19 Red Setting guidelines AND some conditions placed around parents/caregivers and whānau attending.

Therefore, spectators MUST:

- 1. Stay out of the pool area.
- 2. Maintain a physical/social distance of 2 metres from each other.
- 3. QR code in (QR codes at all entry points).
- 4. Wear masks.
- 5. To limit numbers, we ask that only ONE adult per family attend.

Unfortunately, spectators will not be able to assist.

The swimming events are categorised as Junior (Ages 5-6), Intermediate (Ages 7-8) and Senior (Ages 9-10).

Th

e estimated time-frame for the day will be:

- Senior (Ages 9-10) and Intermediate (Age 7-8) 9:15am 12:00pm
- Junior (Ages 5-6) and Intermediate (Age 7) 1:00pm-2:30pm

Your child will need to wear their uniform to school but have the following items on the day:

- swimming togs
- 2 x towels

- bag for wet togs and towels
- school sunhat
- school fleece
- morning tea and lunch
- sunscreen will be provided

Event Structure:

All events will be structured according to each student's age from the Wednesday 2nd February 2022. Points will be earned on an individual and house basis to determine the overall Senior, Intermediate and Junior Champions. Note: Unfortunately, the Reporoa Cluster Swimming Sports Event has been cancelled.

Broadlands School uses Seesaw to:

- allow the children to have a range of experience in sharing their work,
