Covid-19 / Omicron

Things are ramping up a bit in Reporoa Valley at this time, so please take care and use all precautions you can out there!

However, most importantly to the well-being of our school community, please:

- 1. Remain vigilant about symptoms.***
- 2. STAY AWAY if you OR your child show symptoms.***
- 3. If symptoms show, get a test.***
- 4. ONLY HOUSEHOLD CONTACTS of a POSITIVE case must isolate for a period of 10 days and have two negative tests.***
- 5. All other close and casual contacts, including classmates, must be watched closely for symptoms.***
- 6. Advise the Principal immediately if you OR your child were likely POSITIVE whilst at school.***

The school will also isolate your child and contact you immediately IF your child shows symptoms whilst at school.

Our current hygiene, masking, 'bubble', outside space, bus travel and careful event management will continue until further notice. I have also recommended that bus travel occur with great caution, with car travel preferred at this time.

The following diagram may help you...

How to work out your 10 days of self-isolation



start over if you test positive

Find out what you need to do if:	you are positive for COVID-19	you are a Household Contact (living with a positive case)*
Day 0	The day you test positive or start experiencing symptoms, whichever is earliest.	Your Day 0 is the same Day 0 as the first positive case in your household.
Day 3	-	Get a Day 3 test today, or sooner if symptoms develop. If it's positive, start a new 10 days of self-isolation.
Day 10	-	Get a Day 10 test today, or sooner if symptoms develop. If it's positive, start a new 10 days of self-isolation.
Day 11	After 10 days, as long as you are free of COVID-19 symptoms, you will be free to leave self-isolation.	After 10 days, as long as you have a negative Day 10 test result and no COVID-19 symptoms, you will be free to leave self-isolation.

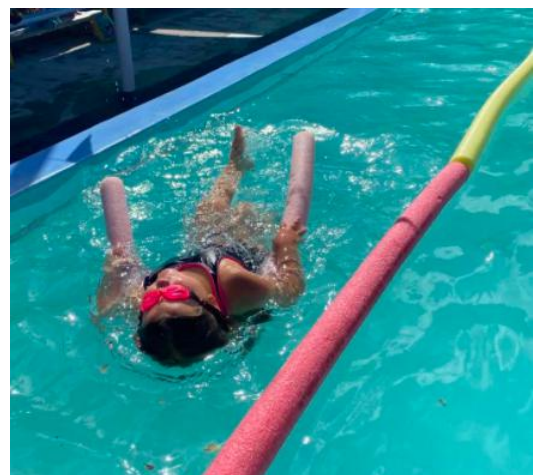
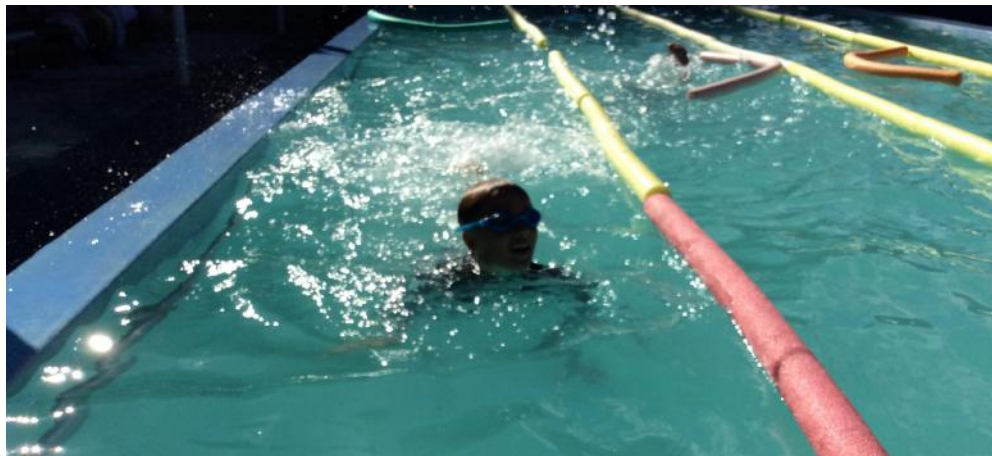

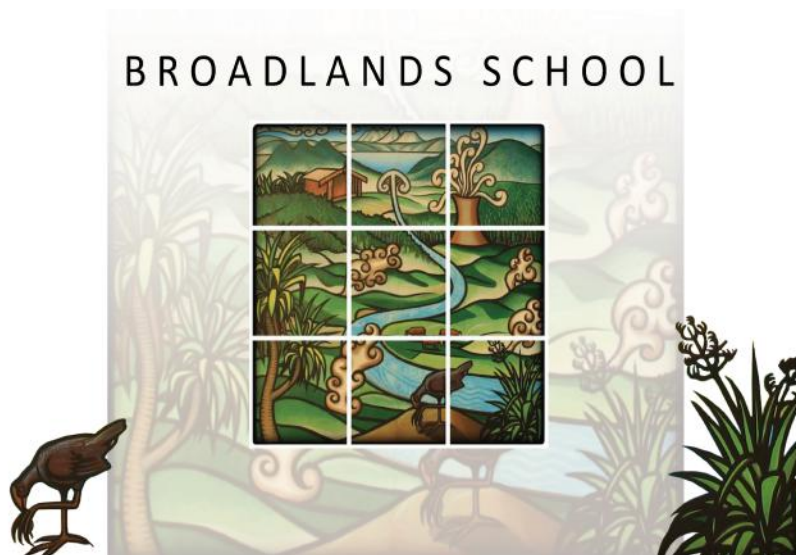
