# Covid-19 can be caught anywhere...is school any less safe? Is home more safe?

As we take so many precautions at school, which we are very strict on, we have done remarkably well (but not surprisingly) as a school with only a relatively small number/% of cases that we know of...virus transition which may or may not be directly linked to Broadlands School.

Rapid Antigen Tests (RATs)

I am pleased to advise that the Ministry of Education (MoE) will provide Rapid Antigen Tests (RAT's) to schools' use in the coming days.

Advice/protocol is as follows:

- If your child is symptomatic at school, you will be phoned. A single RAT will be sent home upon pick-up for you to administer at home. Note: Your child WILL NOT be given a test at school under any circumstances!
- Saff will administer their own tests at school OR at home (if required)
- The school will only be supplying a RAT for symptomatic children, not for general distribution I'm sorry. However, **IF** an **urgent testing** situation arises, please contact the Principal/Graeme for a single RAT.
- Only a single RAT will be sent home, not a box of five.

FYI, **IF** you require your own personal supply of RAT's, log into the **Taupo District Council** site below to register for a free supply based on household numbers.
