Orange Setting

You may now be aware that the NZ Government announced yesterday that, effective **11.59pm** on **Wednesday 13 April**, NZ will be moving to the **Orange Setting**.

This is great news for schools and NZ in-time for the holidays!

Following Ministry of Education advice received yesterday, our position for Term 2 will be as follows:

- → Face masks will be worn Year 4 to 6 only (Rooms 2 & 3)
- → Face masks are to be worn indoors by visitors
- → Good hygiene practices remain (good coughing and sneezing habits)
- → Good classroom ventilation
- → Outdoor 'bubbles' will end (open play and lunching areas)
- → Children stay home if unwell and RAT if required (PS if you require a single RAT, I have them available at school)

also...

- → QR coding into school is not required
- → Mask wearing on the school bus services is not required (only age 12 and up)
- → Visitor/community numbers are not limited outdoors


