Our Reporting to You

As a reminder, especially for our new parents/caregivers, since 2021, we no longer provide traditional formal written reports mid-year and end-of-year.

Covering all curriculum areas over time, our reporting is now through our learning sharing app called **Seesaw** which we expect that you have all downloaded and accessed frequently to see what's going on in your child's class via teacher and student posts.

If you need help here, please ask.

During the year, there are various milestone reporting dates when more formal learning is shared with you. At the end of Term 2 (next week), all teachers will be reporting on your child's learning and curriculum achievement levels in the areas of Writing and Mathematics.

It is hoped that you will more than '*like*' the comments made by your child's teacher, but actually *comment* on your child's achievements and also *talk about* the teacher's comments with your child. This is so powerful as the children see that you are interacting with and valuing their learning achievements.

If you prefer, comments can be by voice by clicking the microphone next to the comment box.

Please appreciate the time your child's teacher has spent preparing these milestone reports. Equally powerful!
