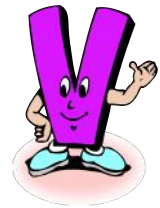

Miss Emma Cordell has been appointed as **Co-Health & PE Lead Teacher**.

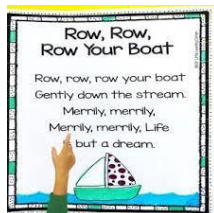
