Seesaw - Our Reporting to You - Reminder #2

At Broadlands School, our reporting to you throughout the year is mainly achieved through Seesaw, our learning sharing app. which you will all be familiar with. This includes Reading, Writing, Mathematics, Science, Digital Technologies/STEAM, Health & PE, Social Sciences and The Arts.

At this time of the year, we will share learning progress and achievement levels in **Writing**, **Mathematics**, **Science** and **Health & PE** (Athletics).

Note #1. Under this digital reporting process at Broadlands School, there are no mid-year and end-of-year reports sent home (as in years' gone by!).

Note #2: If you wish to retain a digital copy of the reporting / your child's Seesaw learning from 2022, you will need to **download** your child's learning as follows by 31.12.22. It won't be there next year!

Sign into your Family or Student account at https://app.seesaw.me.

2. Tap your Profile Icon on the top left

3. Tap Account Settings.

4. Scroll down and tap Download Journal Archives.

5. Tap the 'Download Journal' button for the journal you want to download. This might take a while depending on your Internet speed and how many posts your child has in Seesaw
