This strike action involves teachers and principals covered under the 'Primary Teachers' Collective Agreement' (PTCA) and 'Primary Principals' Collective Agreement' (PPCA) AND who are members of the NZEI.

Formal notification from the NZEI will be received by the Board of Trustees on Monday 13 March regarding its members' intention to take strike action. At this time, the Board will formally advise you of the strike action and how it will be managed. This will include the closure of MOST of Broadlands School, as only ONE non-union teacher will be on-site, supported by two support staff.

The Board understands that this may cause considerable inconvenience to many of you, but we ask that you support our staff to exert their right to take strike action in the interests and benefit of our tamariki, the resourcing (including staffing) of our schools and the teaching profession.


