Emergency Drills@ Broadlands - Important!

At Broadlands School, we have well-established procedures when dealing with emergency situations of which there are four main types:

# Fire, Earthquake, Lockdown Level 1 and Lockdown Level 2

*Lockdown Level 1* involves a scenario whereby the NZ Police advises us of a person in the immediate area whom they believe poses an undue risk to our school community.

*Lockdown Level 2* involves a volcanic eruption (ash clouds), chemical spill, gas pipeline leak, fuel spill, swarm of bees or a mad cow on the loose-type scenarios which may/may not involve the NZ Police and/or Civil Defence.

All situations can be a bit scary for some students which we truly understand, but all staff minimise or eliminate any anxiety or stress.

*Important Note #1*: Should a *Lockdown Level 1* or 2 occur, you will be immediately contacted through **Facebook**, **SchoolApp** and **email**. Instructions will be included.

Earthquake Drill



On Monday 4 March, we will be practising our first emergency drill, being an earthquake.

At a set time, when an earthquake is announced, the students and staff drop, cover and hold. Then when deemed safe to do so, and on the manual bell being rung, we move on to the field for a roll call.
