

Emergency Procedures - *Important!*

Lockdown Level 1 involves a scenario whereby the NZ Police advises us of a person in the immediate area whom they believe poses an undue risk to our school community.

This lockdown can be a bit scary for some students, which we truly understand, but all staff minimise or eliminate any anxiety and talk to their classes with a little 'heads up' that it is going to occur. Our junior classes have already heard this particular sound.

All classes will move quietly and calmly to Rooms 1, 2 & 3 to sit on the floor out of the view with the windows and curtains closed, and all doors locked, for about 15 minutes. This sounds dramatic, but it is important that we practise a drill like this as it could happen at any time in real-life.

Important Note #1: For a *Lockdown Level 1* you will be immediately contacted through **Facebook**, **SchoolApp** and **email** when it starts and ends. Instructions will be included.
