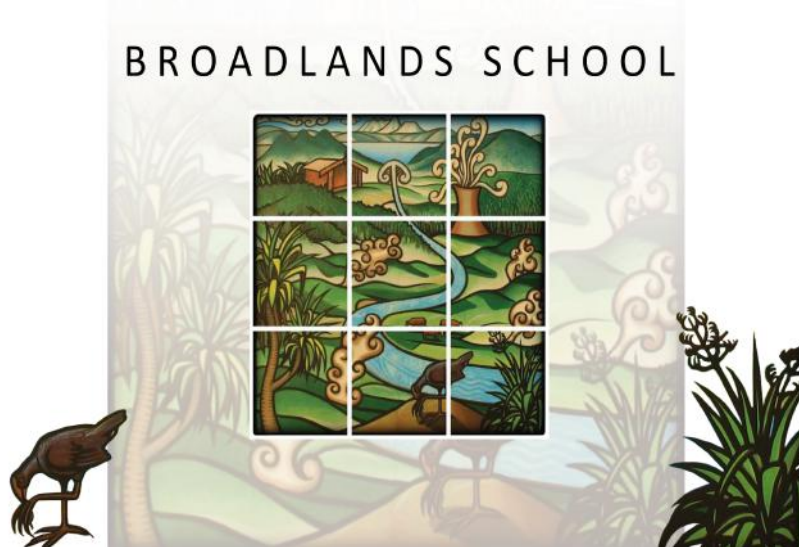

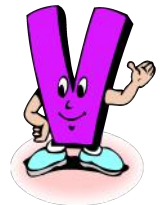

As this is the most important occasion of the year, please respect and maintain the expectations outlined below:

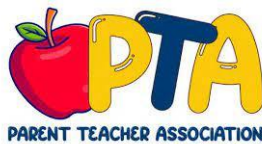
- **ALL** tamariki need to be seated on the floor by **5.50pm**
